What if sin's destruction is its own punishment?




Old Testament Misconceptions


- Jeremiah (Judah) (2 Kings 23:31-25:30, 2 Chron.
 36:2-23) b. 640 BC, and lived beyond the Exile
- Lamentations fall of Jerusalem 586 BC (2 Chron 35:25)
- Obadiah to Edom, but time-frame not clear
- Nahum Between fall of Thebes (663) and Nineveh to Babylon & Media (612)
- Ezekiel first part of Exile 2 Kings 24:11-16 (586/597)
- Daniel in Babylon during captivity 5th & 6th centuries
- Esther Susa, in Persia probably during Xerxes 485-465



- Malachi after completion of the temple during Persian rule (515BC ff)

458 return under Ezra

- Ezra c 458 (2 Chronicles 36:22-33, Isaiah 44:28-45:13) a priest who called Israel back to God
- 432 return under Nehemiah
 - Nehemiah c 432 governor of Judah, rebuild Jerusalem




